Angel Rañon, 95, of Tampa, died Saturday, July 18, 2015. Angel was born in La Devesa, Lugo, Spain, to Domingo Rañon and Ramona Fernandez. 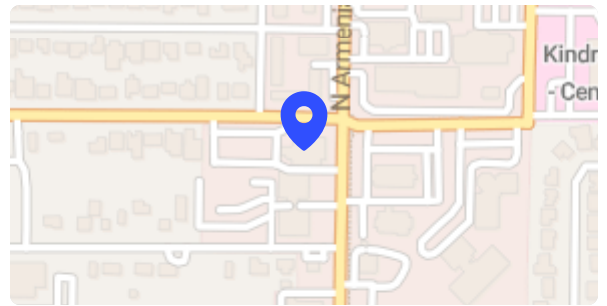

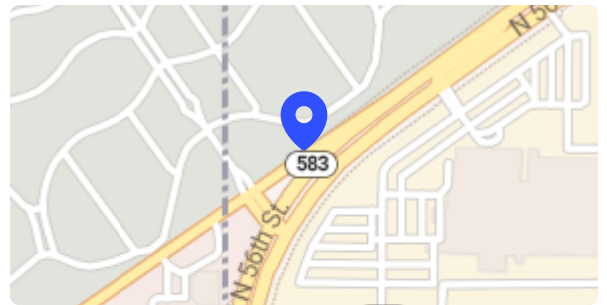
