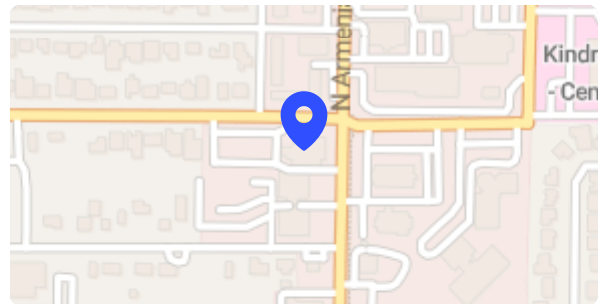
SEP 5, 1940 - AUG 16, 2015

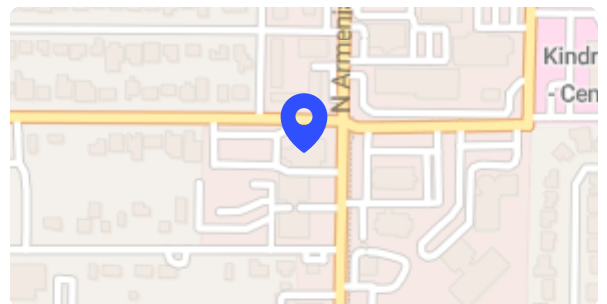
