Sedita, Joe, 95, lifelong Tampa, FL resident went to be with the Lord Jan. 29, 2016. Joe succeeded his father in owning and operating the Oak Tree Market grocery store from his childhood until his retirement in the early 1970's. He served for 4 years in the U.S. Army during WWII and was a parishioner and Eucharistic minister at Our Lady of Perpetual Help Catholic Church. Joe was a member of the Ybor City Roundtable receiving the Sam D. Leto Award in 2006. Joe was active in both the Italian Club of Tampa and the Italian Club cemetery committee where he was a tireless fundraiser and benefactor for the restoration of the club and the perpetual care of the cemetery. He is preceded in death by his parents, Pietro and Maria Sedita and his daughter, Angie Jo Sedita. Survivors include his loving wife of 74 years, Connie P. Sedita, daughter, Marie Polo and husband Mario, grandson, Robbie Polo and wife Devon, great grandson, Austin Polo, niece, Angie Lazzara and husband Robert, nephews, Sam Perrone and wife Charlene and Tony Perrone and wife Lois. 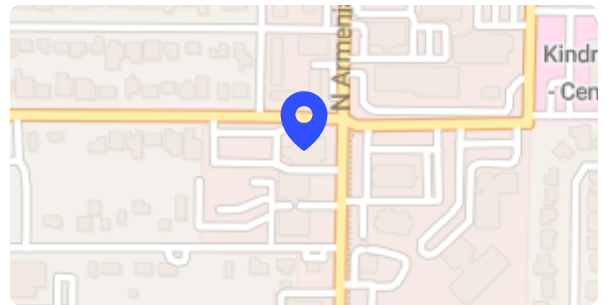

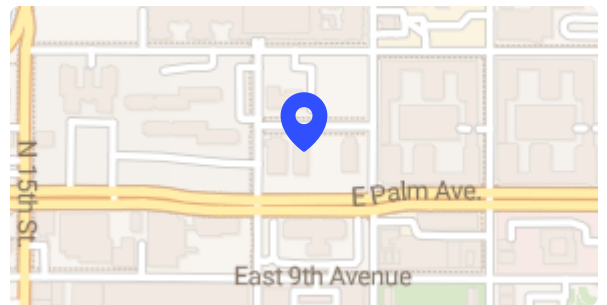

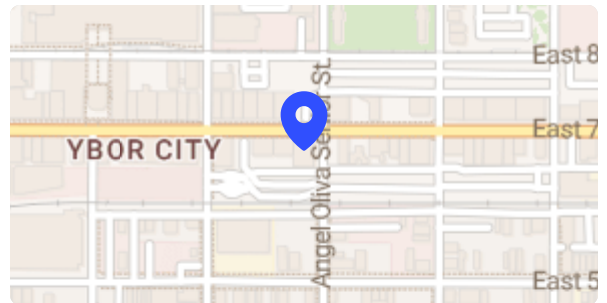
