LETO, Josephine, 99, passed away Thursday, February 9, 2017, just a few weeks shy of her 100th birthday. The life-long West Tampa resident was born in New York City in 1917. One of seven siblings born to Sicilian immigrants Carmela and Nicola Puleo, Josephine grew up in Tampa, worked as a seamstress and at the Del Monte Canning factory in Gary, at the end of Tampa's streetcar line. She was active in the Sons of Italy Lodge and was known and loved for her selfless devotion to her family, especially her seven grandchildren. Josephine is preceded in death by her husband of 63 years, Frank G. 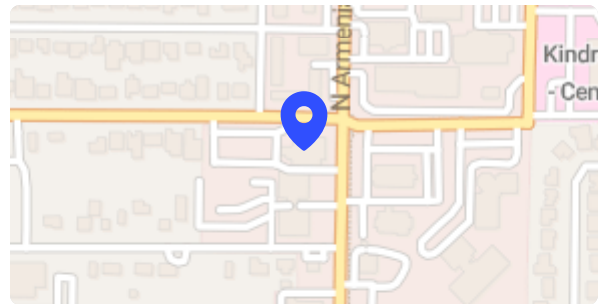

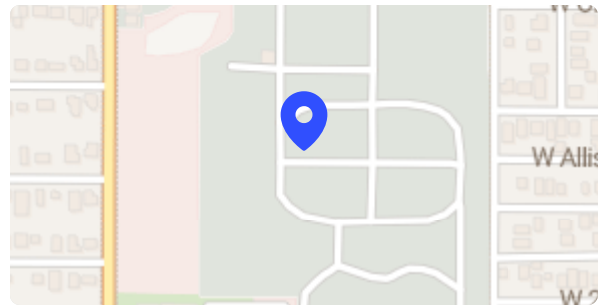

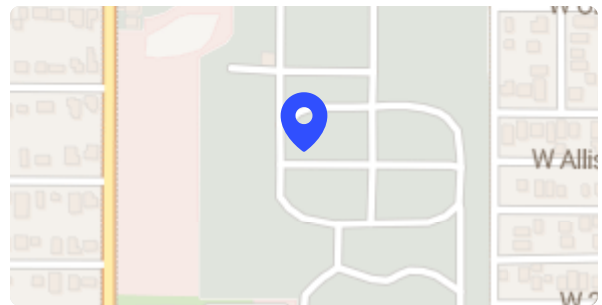
