# Rigoberto Hernandez

SEP 24, 1919 - JUN 10, 2017

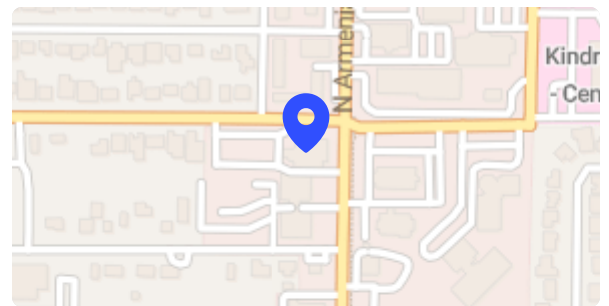

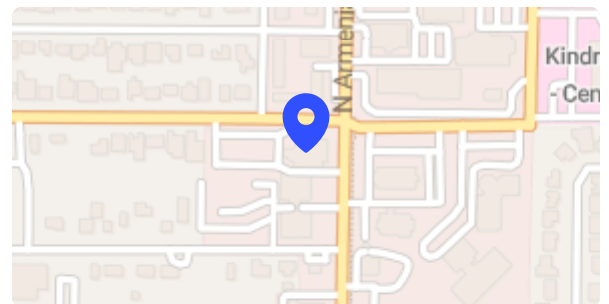

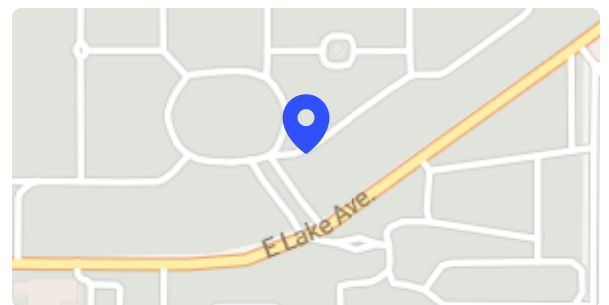
