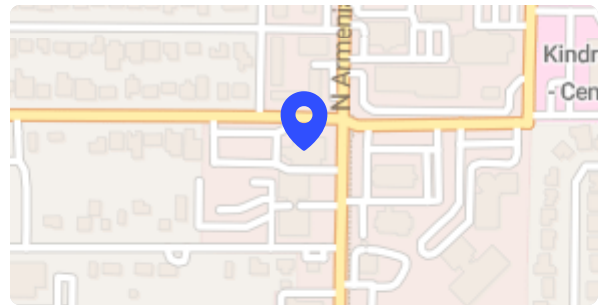
JAN 10, 1929 - OCT 7, 2017

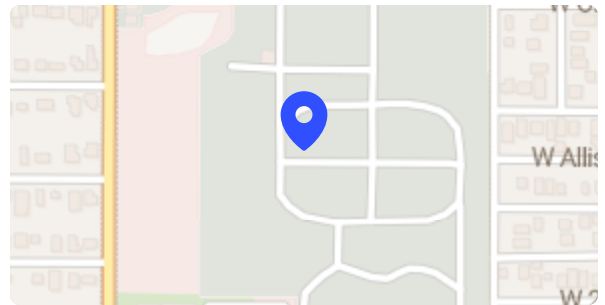

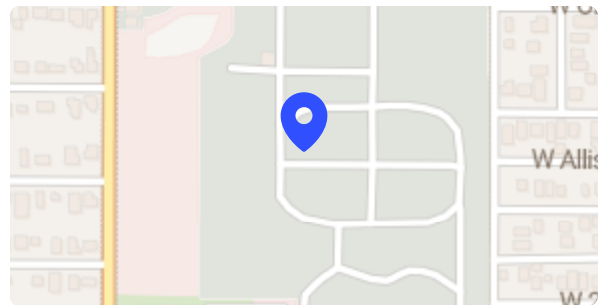
