"Barbara Tanner Lanier was born on May 1st 1934, in Centerville, Pennsylvania and died on February 15th, 2018 at the age of 83. She died peacefully in her home in Clearwater, Florida after a long illness. She was survived by her brother Theodore (Ted) Tanner, her children - Stewart Lanier, Terri Lanier Schisler, and Adam Lanier, 5 grandchildren and 1 great-grandchild.

Barbara was a registered nurse and worked for many years caring for medically fragile children among other healthcare settings. She was an active member of Unity Community Church-Dunedin.
