Josephine (Josie) Gonzalez, 99, passed peacefully on March 7, 2019. She was born in Tampa on February 19, 1920. She is predeceased by her parents Constantino and Celsa Gonzalez and brother, Constantino (Tino) Gonzalez.

Josie attended local elementary and junior high schools, graduating from Hillsborough High School in 1937. She began her professional career as a secretary for Mayor Nick Nuccio after high school graduation and continued working as secretary, first to all Hillsborough County Commissioners and later becoming Commissioner Rudy Rodriguez' secretary. 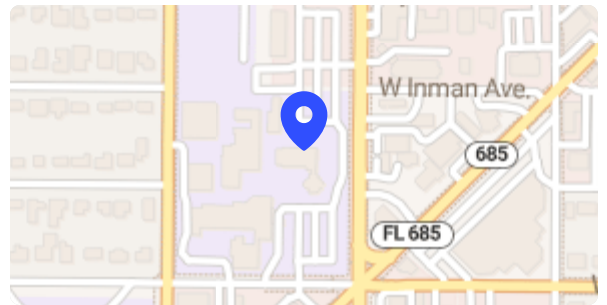

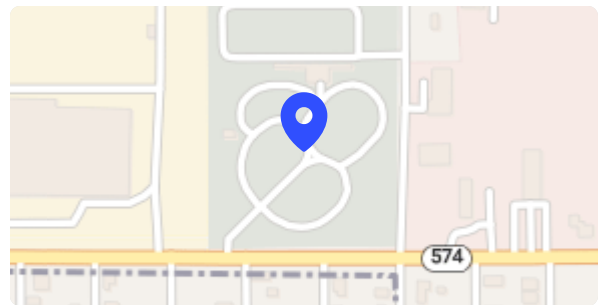
