Orta, Rudy D., 77, passed away on April 22, 2025. He was preceded in death by his parents, Julio and Angelita Orta, and his sister, Arlene Permuy. 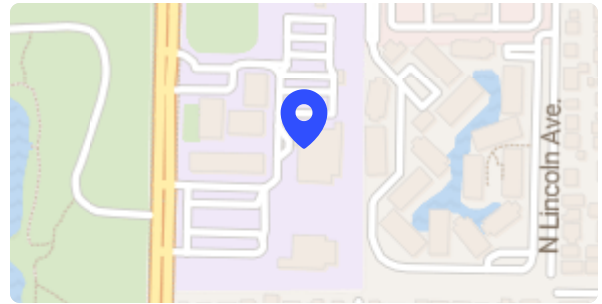

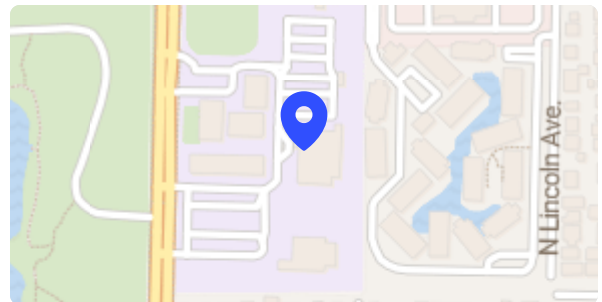
